Ukraine: EU and UNDP deliver modern server equipment to Poltava Oblast Council

The European Union and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in Ukraine have delivered modern server equipment to the Poltava Oblast Council.

It includes two servers, a network firewall, an uninterruptible power supply, switches, a data storage system, and a rack.

This technology will enable more municipalities to use the ASKOD electronic document management system. The ASKOD system ensures fast document exchanges and significantly reduces paper-based processes. Electronic document management reduces information transfer time, provides task control and transparency.

Between January and March 2025, similar equipment will be delivered to

communities in Chernihiv, Sumy, Kharkiv, Mykolaiv, and Dnipropetrovsk oblasts.

The server equipment was delivered to the Poltava Oblast Council as part of the flagship 'EU4Recovery – Empowering Communities in Ukraine' partnership between the UNDP and the EU.
