

EU-Ukraine Association Council to be held on 9 April

April 8, 2025



The tenth meeting of the EU-Ukraine Association Council will take place in Brussels on 9 April 2025. It will discuss political matters and bilateral relations.

The European Union and Ukraine will exchange views on the situation following Russia's war of aggression, focusing on the military, economic and humanitarian situation on the ground and the response to Russia's war. They will then touch on wider global and regional issues.

Participants will also exchange views on the bilateral agenda, touching on the implementation of the Association Agreement since the start of Russia's war of aggression, reconstruction and reforms in Ukraine, and EU financial assistance.

The meeting will be chaired by Denys Shmyhal, Prime Minister of Ukraine, and Kaja Kallas, High Representative of the European Union for Foreign

Affairs and Security Policy.
