

EU4Youth IV: three-day capacity building training for youth CSOs held in Zhytomyr, Ukraine

26 July 2024



On 24-26 July, a three-day training for youth civil society organisations took place in Zhytomyr, Ukraine.

The primary aim of the event was to equip participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively engage with young people under the challenging circumstances of war and in the post-war period.

Over the course of three days, 30 young individuals from across Ukraine engaged in a range of activities designed to foster teamwork, project writing, and practical learning experiences. The participants improved their understanding of the youth policy ecosystem in Ukraine, youth project management and the nuances of communication with authorities to build sustainable partnerships.

The training was organised by the Ministry of Youth and Sports of Ukraine in

collaboration with the Zhytomyr Regional Military Administration with the support of the 'EU4Youth IV: Youth Engagement and Empowerment' project, co-funded by the European Union and German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and implemented by the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ).
