Borrell to "peace lovers": the fastest way to peace is for Russia to withdraw its troops from Ukraine

Speaking at the UN Security Council on 24 September in New York, EU High Representative Josep Borrell addressed the so-called "peace lovers" – those, in Borrell's understanding, who are disappointed that the EU has provided support to Ukraine that prevented it from losing the war quickly.

"They want peace quickly, [in] the quickest possible way. But they have not mentioned that the quickest possible way [towards peace] is Russia withdrawing their troops from Ukraine," Borrell said. "Yes, there is another way, Ukrainian surrender. But we do not want this kind of ending [of] the war."

He also said Ukraine's surrender would be a "good example" for the perpetrator "to start [doing it] again and again".

In his press remarks after the Council, Borrell added: "We do not want Ukraine

surrendering and losing its national identity, its freedom and its territory, and becoming a second Belarus. That has to be clear."
