

Ukraine: EU, UNDP and partners deliver 10 vehicles for providing mobile services in war-affected communities

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in Ukraine, with support from the European Union and the governments of Canada and Denmark, and in partnership with the Ministry of Health of Ukraine and the Ministry of Social Policy of Ukraine, has delivered 10 specially equipped vehicles to enhance recovery and development processes at local level.

The vehicles will support health care and social services in Dnipropetrovsk, Kherson, Mykolaiv, and Zaporizhzhia oblasts. They will address the growing strain on health and social services caused by the war and help fill gaps such as staff shortages and lack of specialised services.

The initiative is part of UNDP's broader efforts to bolster health care and social support systems in Ukraine, focusing on critical areas such as palliative care, family doctor services and psychosocial support. These efforts include providing vehicles, office equipment and furniture to medical and social institutions, particularly in war-affected communities.
